Call for presenters:

Jan Moody – Against this Local Improvement. How does this better our Community? There is no guarantee for a bed. Would like to have money go to Collingwood instead. If we have this money than we should give directly to the Collingwood. Rather than sending to Carman. How do we speculate money coming from the recycling program, thinks if she wanted to give to the project she prefers not to be forced, stated that Morden and Stanley did not go to their tax payers for funds when Tabor Home was built.

Joann Knox – has same concerns as Jan Moody feels it's an insult to have to give money to another Community, shows great disrespect, how can we call it a local improvement plan when it is not a local project. If other communities came to us for a hand out would we be able to give to them as well. Taking money from our wallets to give to another Town.

Shawn McCutcheon - explained how the R.M. of Thompson fits into the catchment area and the benefits to both Boyne Care Holdings as well as the R.M. of Thompson of being part of this project.

Robert Prodinski – not against the project but feels it was approached wrong, would prefer to be able to have made a tax deductible donation rather than pay by way of Local Improvement.

Ernie Kroeker – Read objection letter against the proposal.

Glen Lawson – Read a presentation in favor of the project.
