Rules and Regulations

1. All persons subscribing the sum of \$10.00 or over shall become members of the Society for the year and all exhibitors of livestock are to be members.
2. Cattle entry fee is 10 percent of first place.
3. Cattle must be on the grounds no later than 8:30 a.m. on the day of the fair.
4. All animals in a herd must be owned by one exhibitor, except in the get of one sire.
5. All animals must be free of disease.
6. Each animal brought to the fair must be provided with proper means of fastening.
7. Certificates of all purebred stock must be produced for the judges if required.
8. In the absence of competition in any section, or if stock or articles be of an inferior quality, the judges are instructed to award only such premium as they think the article of stock is deserving of. They shall exercise their discretion as to whether they will award the second or any prize.
9. The management reserves the right to combine two or more of the classes or sections in all classes of livestock if they deem necessary.
10. The Directors will consider payment of prizes for entries not appearing in the prize list, but recommended by the judges.
11. No person will be allowed to interfere with the judges while in the discharge of their duties. Exhibitors so interfering will forfeit their right to any premiums to which they might otherwise be entitled.
12. Cheques will be made payable at par at Miami.
13. No exhibit will be allowed to compete in more than one section of a class but may compete in team, herd, group or collection.
14. The Directors will take every possible precaution to secure the safety of animals sent to the exhibition, and should any exhibit be accidentally injured, lost or stolen they will give assistance in their power toward the recovery of same, but shall not be liable to payment for its value.
15. A meeting of the Directors will be held to hear and decide any complaints or grievances that may have arisen in awarding prizes. Protests may be made in writing to the secretary within ten (10) days after the fair. A deposit

- of \$50.00 must accompany the protests, which fee shall be forfeited if the protesting party fails to make good his or her claim.
16. The Society reserves the right to pay prize money in proportion to receipts. Under no circumstances will the Society be liable to pay prize money in excess of the net revenue derived from the fair.
 17. Qualifying ages to be of January 1st of the present year.
 18. No more than two entries in each section of livestock classes allowed to each exhibitor.
 19. No cross entry between ponies and horses.
 20. Entries may be made by phone or mail ***prior to Saturday, June 22nd, 2019*** or in person the ***day prior to*** the fair from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. at the fair office.
 21. If mailing entries, please allow at least one week. Entries may be phoned in any time to the Secretary ***prior to*** Friday, June 21st. 2019. Entries and payment will be accepted from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Friday at the Fair Office.
